



Dr. Joann Halpern was the founding director of the German Center for Research and Innovation, New York (Deutsches Wissenschafts- und Innovationshaus), a cornerstone of the German government's initiative to internationalize science and research. She is currently the director of the Hasso Plattner Institute, New York and an adjunct professor in the Department of Applied Statistics, Social Science and Humanities at New York University. She also served as a grant evaluator for Horizon 2020. In addition to teaching and administrative assignments at universities in the United States and Germany, Dr. Halpern co-founded Knowledge Transfer Beyond Boundaries, an NGO with projects in Cameroon, Nigeria, Yemen, and Antigua. She received her B.A. from Dartmouth College, her M.A. from Harvard University, and her Ph.D. from New York University. She is a recipient of the Harvard University Award for Distinction in Teaching as well as scholarships and fellowships from the Fulbright Association, German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), Robert Bosch Stiftung, and the National Endowment for the Humanities. She serves on the advisory boards of the German Center for Research and Innovation, Technical University of Dortmund, German Accelerator, Charité Entrepreneurship Summit, University Alliance Ruhr, and the External Advisory Board of the Tandon Institute for Invention, Innovation, and Entrepreneurship.
